- Grant funded collaborations between nine Illinois libraries via Illinois Cooperative Collection Management Program
 - Total project cost: \$24,000
 - Range of library commitment: \$2,500 to \$4,000
- Covered multiple facets of multicultural education: administrative, legal, curricular, admissions, pedagogy, and children's literature




