**IDforDeduplication:** Notice how the IDforDeduplication is three different numbers for these three rows. Since these numbers are different, but the NORMAL\_HEADING\_2450 values are identical, this means that these three rows represent three separate patron requests.

**YourLibBIB\_ID:** The value in each of these rows is the same, meaning that your library has one BIB where the record has the same NORMAL\_HEADING 2450 value.

**RequestNetworkNumber and YourLibNetworkNumber:** Notice that the OCLC number for the item the patron requested matches the OCLC numbers in your library's bib. Your library does have an exact copy of the item requested by the patron.

**RequestPubDate and YourLibPubDate:** These values can help you determine which edition or publication year the patron requested, vs. the edition/publication year owned at your library. For some requests the publication year may matter more than others. With this request, your library owns the same year as the patron requested.

**NORMAL\_HEADING\_2450:** These three results all have the same normalized title. Using other information about the title, such as author, publisher, publisher date, and OCLC number can help you confirm a match.
